




Values-Based and Sustainable Innovation Special Interest Group (SIG)








SIG activities between July 2023 and July 2024 focussed on topics of Values-Based and Sustainable Innovation Cultures, Sustainability Foresight, and Sustainable Business Model Design – main results are publicly available:
